OFFICE ORDER

Pursuant to the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Department of Personnel letter No. PER (AP) C-B (2)/2015 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2016 and on the recommendations of Departmental Screening Committee constituted vide this office order No. 1-32/2006 - 27727 - 32 dated 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2016, the services of Sh. Rakesh Chandla and Smt. Suman Lata, Clerks appointed on contract basis against the vacant posts of Clerks vide this office order No. 1-16/2003-31043 dated 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2011, on completion of five years of their services as on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 are hereby regularized in the pay scale of Rs. 5910-20200+1900/- Grade Pay with immediate effect on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The appointments are purely temporary but likely to continue.
2. They shall be on probation for a period of two years in the first instance and during the period of probation, their services can be terminated at any time without giving any notice.
3. They will produce certificates of their educational qualification if not produced.
4. They will produce Bonafide Himachali Certificate from the Magistrate, Ist Class if not produced.
5. They will produce the certificates of their age if not produced.
6. They will be the member of Group Insurance Scheme as introduced by the Government of Himachal Pradesh.
7. They will produce medical fitness certificate from the Chief Medical Officer, Shimla.
8. They will produce the certificate of Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe/ Ex-serviceman as the case may be, from the Magistrate Ist Class concerned.
9. The regularization shall be subject to the verification of character antecedents as provided in the Himachal Pradesh Financial Rules.
10. The contractual appointee who are regularized shall be liable to be posted anywhere within the State.
11. They will take the oath of allegiance/faithfulness to the Constitution of India.
12. They will submit a declaration to the effect that they shall have not more than one living wife/husband.

If the regularization on the above terms and conditions are acceptable to them, they should report for duty to the undersigned within seven days positively, failing which their regularization will be treated as cancelled.
