A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Himschal Pradesh Public Service Commission or other recruiting authority, but the offer of appintment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government of India/Government of Himschal Pradesh.

3. Upper age-limit for direct recruits will not be applicable to the candidate already in the service of the Government.

4. Upper age-limit is relaxable for Scheduled Castes/ Tribes candidates and other categories of persons to the extent permissible under the general or specical orders of the H. P. Government.

Age-limit for direct recruits will be reckoned from the last date fixed for receipt of applications by the Commission.

Age and experience for direct lectuits relexable at the discretion of the Commission in the case of cardidates otherwise well-qualified.

7. Provisions of columns 10 and 11 are to be revised by the Government in consultation with the Commission as and when the number of posts under column 2 are increased or decreased.

8. Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Himschal Pradesh Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or post.

9. Selection for appointment to these posts in the case of direct recruitment, shall be made on the basis of viva vace test, if the Commission so considers necessary or expedient by a written test, the standard/syllable etc. of which will be determined by the Commission or a practical test. test:

10. In all cases where a junior person becomes eligible for consideration by virtue of his total length of service (including ad hoc one) in the feeder post, all persons senior to him in the respective category shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration and placed above the junior persons in the field of consideration:

Provided that all incumbents to be considered for promotion/confirmation shall possess the minimum qualifying service of at least three years or that prescribed in the relevant recruitment and promotion rules for the post whichever is less:

Provided further that where a person becomes ineligible to be considered for promotion/confirmation, on account of the requirement prescribed in the preceding proviso, the person(s) junior to him shall also be deemed to be ineligible for consideration for such promotion/confirmation.
